New Brunswick Free Public Library

New Brunswick offers opportunities for adult emerging bilinguals who are interested in improving their English language skills. They offer a **Virtual English Conversation Groups**. These conversation groups are for adult language learners (over age 18) who can speak some English. Each week the group will discuss a topic in English to help improve their conversational skills. **Advance registration is required** to get the Zoom link for these virtual programs.

They also offer an **English Conversation Café**. Are you interested in practicing English and meeting new people? Join one or more of our English Conversation Cafés! This program is an informal conversation practice group for adult language learners who can hold a simple conversation in English. Participants engage in one-on-one or small-group conversations with Conversation Facilitators discussing a variety of topics. You must be over the age of 18 to participate. **Registration is required.** You can register online or at the library.

They also offer **Citizenship Classes** 5:30 - 8:30 p.m. on Tuesdays in 2025. (Check calendar for exact dates.) This class is available for beginner and intermediate English learners who are legal Permanent Residents (Green Card holders). During the class, you will work with certified teachers and tutors to improve your English. The teachers are Board Certified to represent you with your citizenship case.
