## NJ SNAP Applicant Required Document Checklist

The information is the proof needed to get benefits.

**The proof documents** for SNAP Applicant in your household who is applying are listed below: (must items)

- **A valid ID** (i.e. driver's license, birth certificate, government ID) of **each household member**
- **Proof of where you live** (i.e. lease, rental agreement, utility bill)
- Proof of earned income (i.e. paystubs, employer letter, recent tax records)
- Proof of unearned income (benefits award letter)
- Proof of resources (i.e. bank statements)
- Social Security Number of each household member
- Proof of immigration status (for non-citizens)
- Proof of student status (for college students)

The following information is for getting more benefits by providing:  
(good to have items)

- Housing costs (i.e. rent receipt, mortgage statement, property tax bills)
- Phone and utility costs
- Medical expenses for anyone in your household 60+ or disabled
- Child and adult care costs
- Child support paid by a person in your household
