## History

The Van Pelt Family Burying Ground is one of many burial areas in Monmouth County, New Jersey, in use from the 18th to the early 20th century. Land that the cemetery occupies was first owned by Walter Van Pelt of Kings County, New York, who in 1717, purchased 300 acres from Hendrick Van Gelder for 160 English pounds. The earliest known burial was that of Walter Hyer in 1796 although earlier burials may exist. A small headstone, now fragmented, bore a very weathered inscription with a date of either 1718 or 1798. Another marker, broken off below its inscription, is also likely of 18th century. Additional early burials may exist but were either not marked at the time of the burial or the markers were later removed or lost.

In 1876, the will of Peter P. Van Pelt provided for a plot of two chains square (132' x 132'), to be enclosed by a picket fence. No metes and bounds are known prior to this mention. Van Pelt's will further stated that the burying ground was for the use of the Van Pelt family, "in the line of Peter P. Van Pelt, father of the testator." A right-of-way for access was to be provided. The last known burial was that of Jacob J. Van Pelt in 1906.

This type of burying ground passed into obsolescence during the 20th century in favor of larger cemeteries, both church-run and non-sectarian. Several later family members are interred at Rose Hill Cemetery in Matawan and Green Grove Cemetery in Keyport, New Jersey.

The Van Pelt Burying Ground is located in Aberdeen, New Jersey, between Fordham Drive, Fair Lane and Faith Lane, with access provided by an unmarked easement to the right of 25 Faith Lane. It is overgrown with brush. Only traces of a fence and gate on the east side are evident. About half of the 25 known burials have foot stones.

## Gravestone Inscriptions

The following inscriptions were transcribed by Aberdeen Township Historian Edward Fitzgerald and George Joynson:

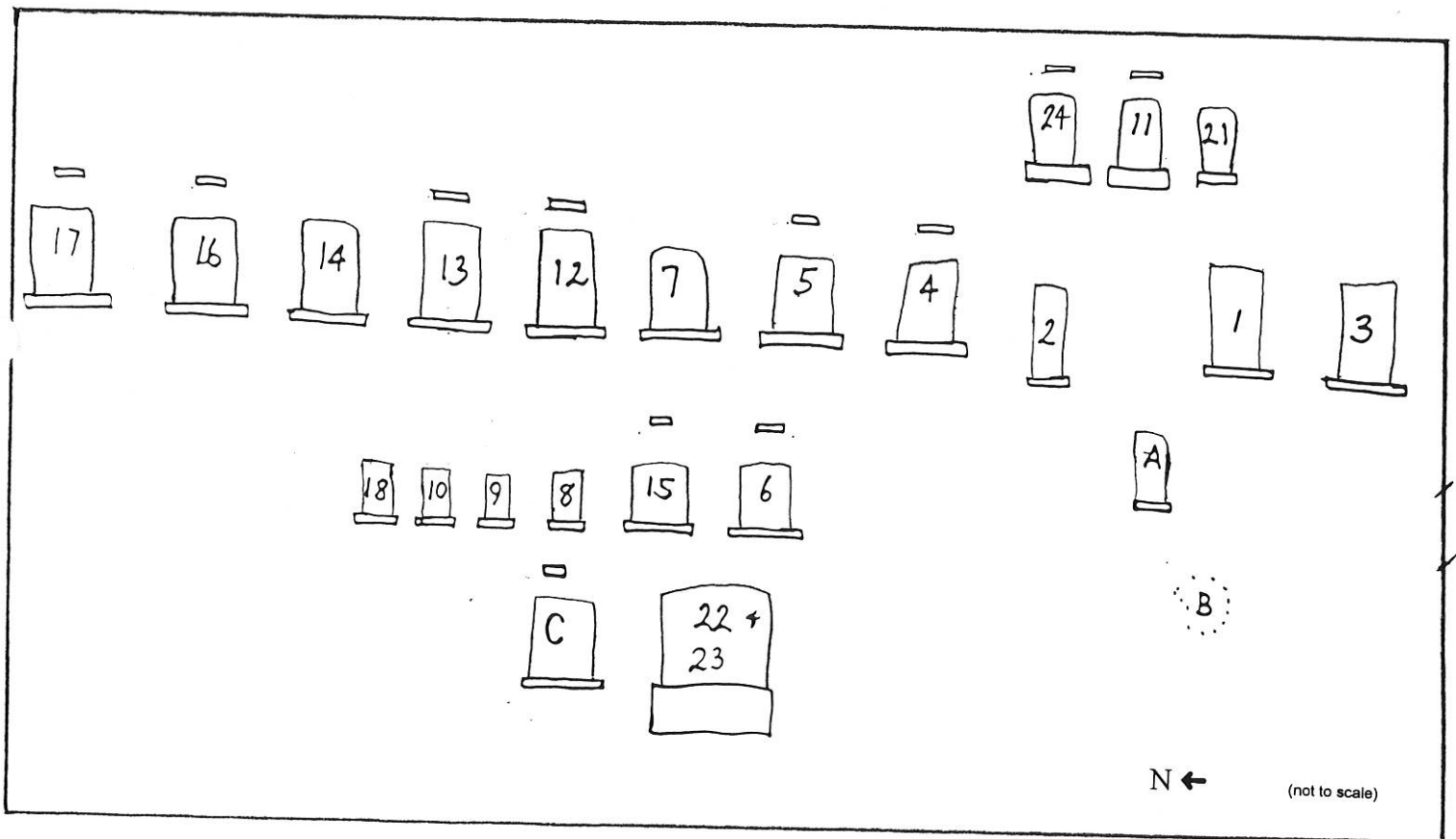

# Layout

Every gravestone was placed facing the same direction, so that the visitor can read each inscription when facing east. Bodies were buried *behind*, or east of, the marker and foot stones were placed marking the easternmost point of burial.

This method of burial is unusual compared to the traditional method of placing the headstone at the back of the burial with the body buried in front of the headstone.

## Survey Summaries

In 1935, Ruth Dibbin, member of the Daughters of the American Revolution, surveyed 16 burials but this survey is inaccurate and incomplete. Dibbin's survey is reported in DAR Volume 185, pages 52-53, (see Appendix A).

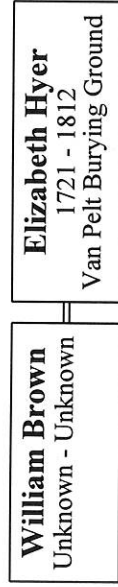
Ed Raser surveyed the markers in March 1959 and again in November 1995. Raser's survey of 22 burials is reported in "Monmouth County Gravestones: Some Small Burial Grounds," on page 121-122 in the September 1998 issue of New Jersey Genealogical Magazine (see Appendix C).

Aberdeen Township Historian Edward Fitzgerald surveyed the markers in the 1980's and again in November 1998. Fitzgerald's survey included poetic inscriptions and information on two brown sandstone markers near Walter Hyer's 1796 brown sandstone marker. His survey included 25 named burials and 2 unnamed burials (see Appendix B).

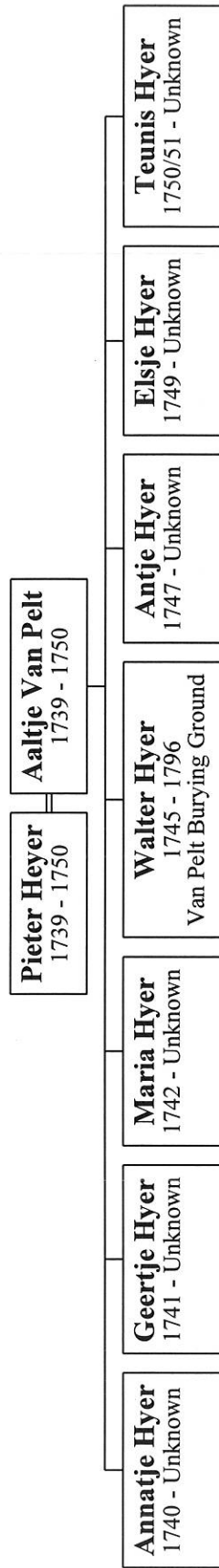
In November 1998, George Joynson surveyed the markers. Joynson and Fitzgerald then used additional sources to eliminate discrepancies. Sources included: monument paper pressings to read worn markers; obituary information from the Matawan Journal available at the Matawan Aberdeen Public Library; religious records of the Old Brick Church available at the Monmouth County Historical Society; records in the Monmouth County Archives; township wills and deeds, Mormon Church International Genealogical Index and Ancestral Files, and [www.ancestry.com](http://www.ancestry.com) on the Internet.

Fitzgerald and Joynson worked together to produce this final report. Copies are also available at the Matawan Aberdeen Library on Main Street in Matawan, Monmouth County Historical Association and Monmouth County Archives. 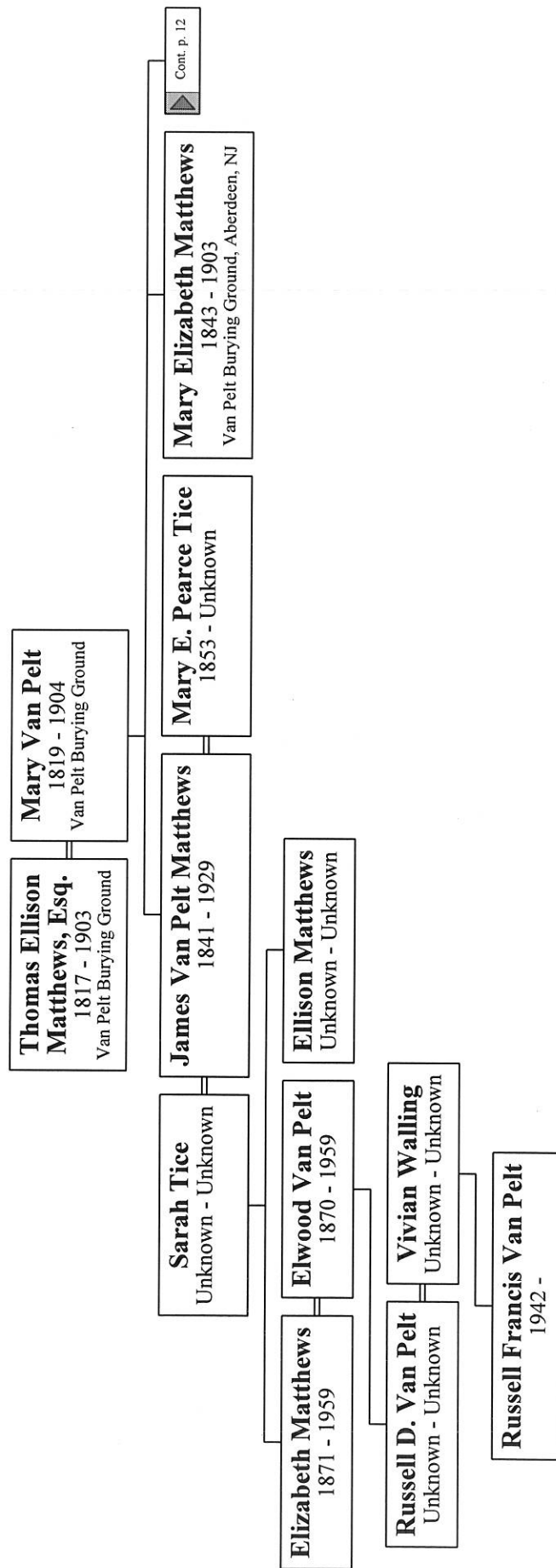
# Descendant Tree for Elizabeth Hyer

# Descendant Tree for Thomas Ellison Matthews

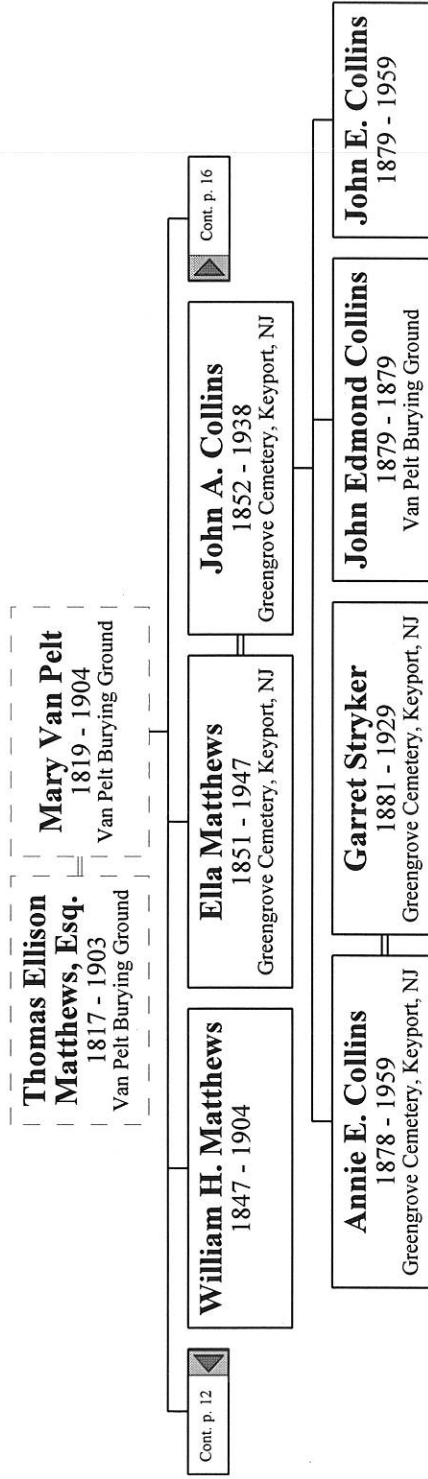

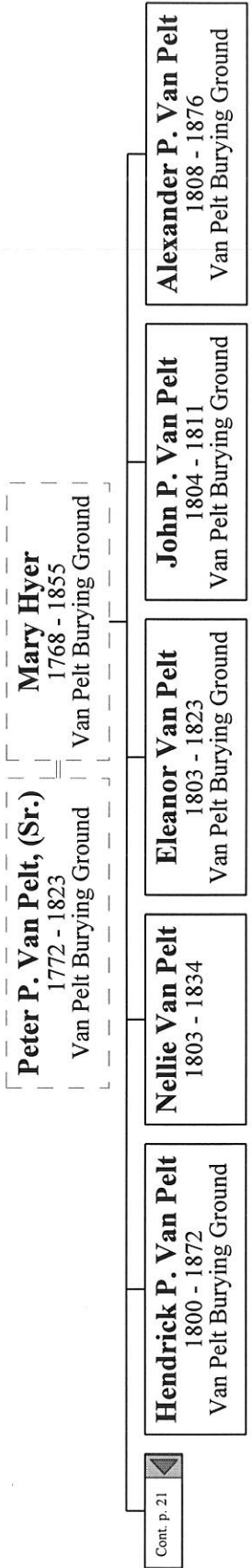




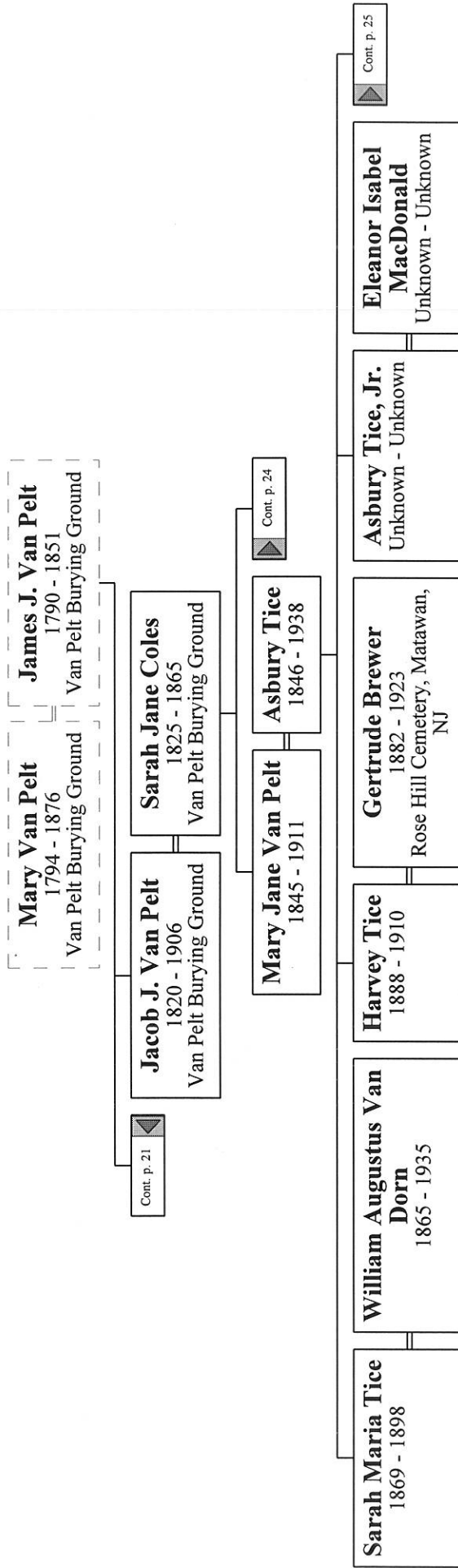
# Descendant Tree for Peter P. Van Pelt (Sr)



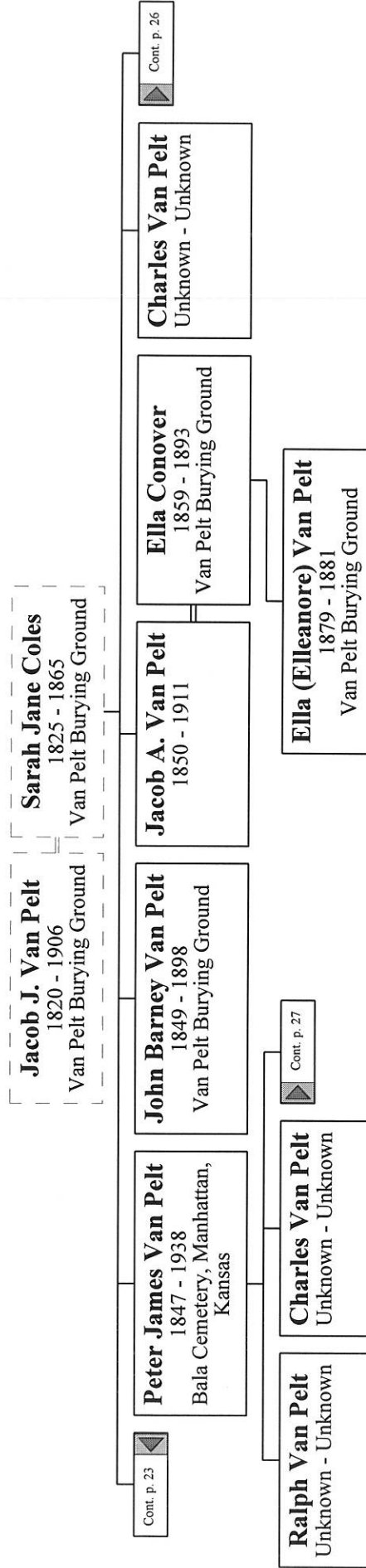

## Ed Raser's 1995 Survey Appendix C:

### Van Pelt Family Burial Ground

When Edward J. Raser visited this burial ground in March 1959 it was in a relatively open field in the countryside. Except for several fallen stones, and one broken in pieces, most stones were standing and in good condition. Unfortunately, someone claiming the burials were on his property was so uncooperative that the copying effort had to be terminated before all the inscriptions could be copied. When revisited in November 1995 the burial ground was found to be in the center of a housing development, within a densely overgrown and wooded half-acre lot completely surrounded by houses. Now close to half of the stones are fallen and many are broken, and most of them show excessive erosion from the damp groundcover of bushes and weeds. Surprisingly, the brownstone of Walter Hyer, a Revolutionary War soldier, is still in excellent condition. All other stones are typical white sandstones except for the granite monument for Thomas E. Matthews and his wife.

Neighbors report that over the years children have vandalized the graveyard and carted off pieces of some gravestones. While every effort was made to locate previously uncopied stones, it is possible that one or two gravestones may have been removed, or gone undiscovered despite attempts to probe for fallen stones. The only other copy of the inscriptions found was prepared for the DAR about 1935; it proved to be grossly incomplete and inaccurate. Some Van Pelt family data can be found in Old Brick Church records, which indicate that Peter P. Van Pelt's wife was Mary Hyer.

To find this Aberdeen Township burial ground proceed northeasterly on Lloyd Road, from its beginning at highway NJ-79, almost 0.8 mile to the second entrance to Fordham Drive on the left. Proceed up Fordham Drive to the second street (Faith Lane) on the left, then up Faith Lane about 250 feet. The burial ground is on the right, behind the house at 25 Faith Lane; a reserved access way is located on the right side of that house. To aid in finding the stones, the four rows have been numbered from front to back, as seen viewing the inscriptions, and from left to right. For some unknown reason there is a wide gap between stones 9 and 10 in row 3.
