Check Out a Public Library Book For

Kindle & Kindle Fire

<u>First create an Amazon.com account, this allows you to download FREE</u> books onto your Amazon Kindle and Kindle Fire.

Next, register your Kindle device. Click the pinwheel on the top right hand of your Kindle. Then click 'More', then 'My Account,' and register your Kindle.

Now to search and check out books for free:

- 1. Go to www.matawanaberdeenlibrary.com.
- 2. Click on Downloads.
- 3. Click on eBooks, then on eLibraryNJ.
- 4. In the upper right hand corner, click on 'Sign In.'
- 5. Choose Libraries of Middlesex Automation Consortium from the drop-down list.
- 6. Type in your library card number, which is located on the back of your library card. The pin number is the last four digits of your card number.
- 7. Click 'Sign In.'
- 8. Click on 'Advanced Search' which will bring you to the Advanced Search Page.
- 9. Select 'Kindle Books' from the Formats field.
- 10. Include other search items (author, title, series), if you wish to narrow down your search.
- 11. Choose 'Show only copies with titles available.'
- 12. Click search.
- 13. To borrow a book, simply select the title you wish to borrow and click 'Borrow'. (If the book is not available, you can place a hold by entering your email address and wait to be notified that the title is available. You will have 2 days after you receive the email notification to borrow the material)
- 14. Click on 'Go to Checkouts.'
- 15. Click on 'Download', choose 'Kindle Book.'
- 16. Click on 'Confirm & Download.' (This will take you to Amazon.com)
- 17. Click on 'Get Library Book' in the green box on the right hand corner.
- 18. Sign into your Amazon.com account.
- 19. Choose where you want the eBook to be delivered, either your Kindle OR transfer via computer. Then click 'Continue.'
- 20. Click on 'Download Now' if you are connected to Wi-Fi. The book will appear on the home screen of your device when it is finished downloading.
